FUELS MANAGEMENT PROJECTS

STATE FIRE CREW PROPERTY CLEARING, PRIVATE CITIZEN CLEARING, AND FUELS REMOVAL



- State Fire Crews cleared trees and hazardous fuels on 63 properties in 2009.
- These 63 properties amounted to 146 acres of clearing and piling.
- The fuels from 33 properties, without access for pick-up, were piled for winter burning.
- The fuels from 30 properties, and some partial properties, were hauled off to the brush pit.
- Citizens clearing amounted to 3,330 private pick-ups totaling 1,012 tons hauled to the brush pit.

- State Fire Crews have been busy since the first storm in November and have completed burning on 16 of 33 properties. Our goal is to finish the remaining 17 properties within these winter months. This would clean up all 2009 completed clearings.

ADDITIONAL GRANT ACCOMPLISHMENTS

- We have accumulated over 200 Fire Hazard Property Assessments per NFPA standards. Aside from Fuels Management, these will be used in our Red Zone mapping program and can be put in place for pre-incident planning to help enhance our structure protection within our Fire Department.
- The Fuels Management Program has brought in \$198,772 in funds from the State WUI Grant for year ending 2009.
- Billed and received \$45,054 from citizen payments for State Fire Crew clearing and burning.
